Jacob had two children with his beloved wife Rachel



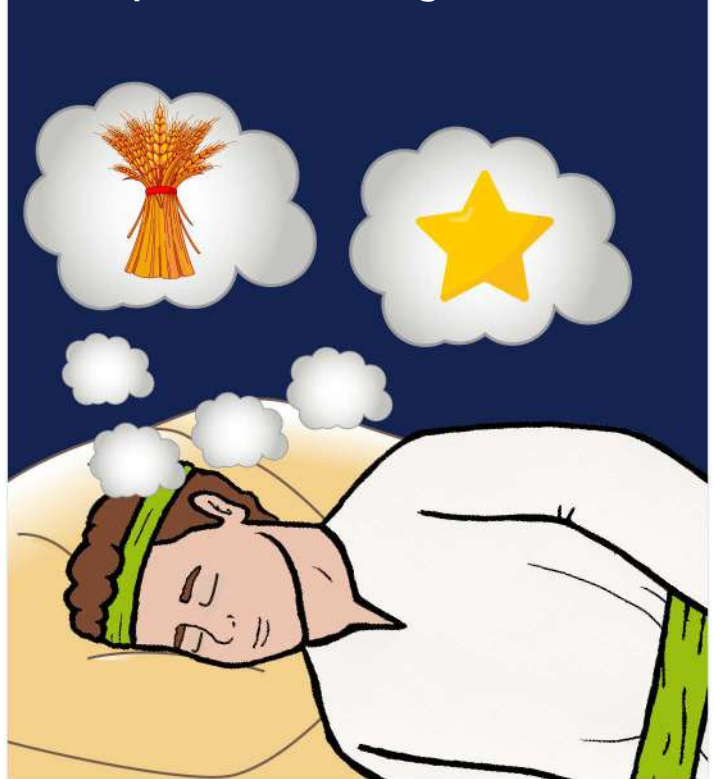
In old age Jacob was left with Joseph and Benjamin. His wife died. He loved his son Joseph more than all his children.

"...Behold, I have dreamed a dream more; and, behold, the sun and the moon and the eleven stars made obeisance to me."

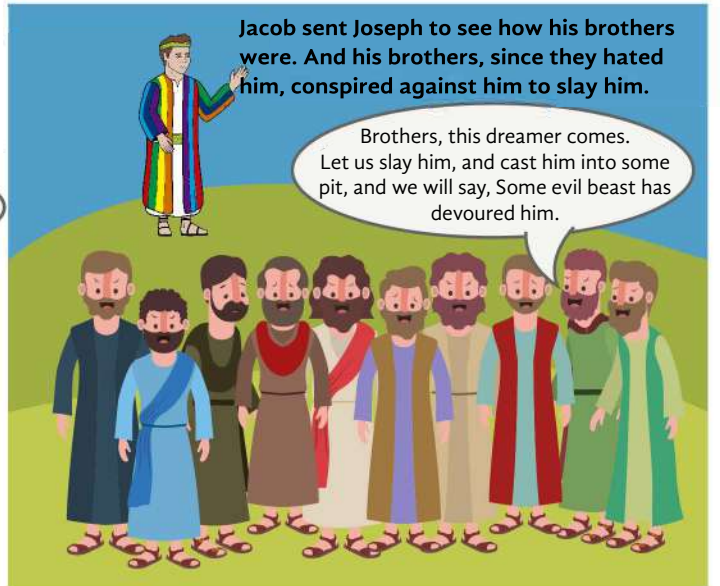


What is this dream that you have dreamed? Shall I and your mother and your brothers indeed come to bow down ourselves to you to the earth?

Brothers, this dreamer comes. Let us slay him, and cast him into some pit, and we will say, Some evil beast has devoured him.



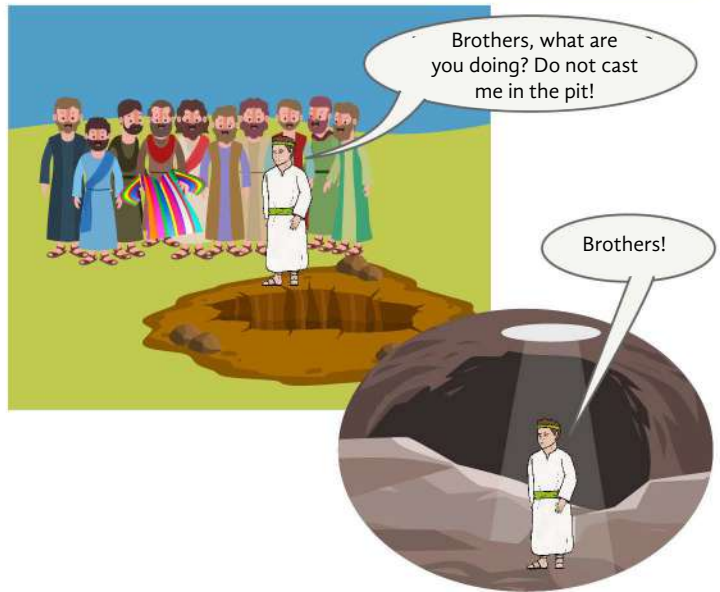
Let us not kill him; but cast him into this pit.

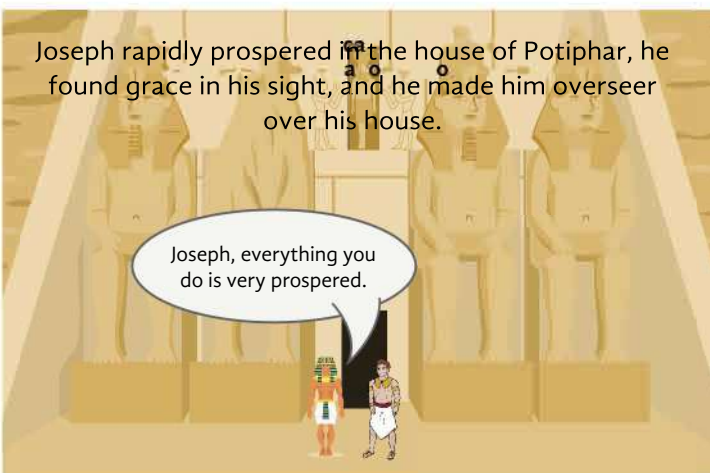
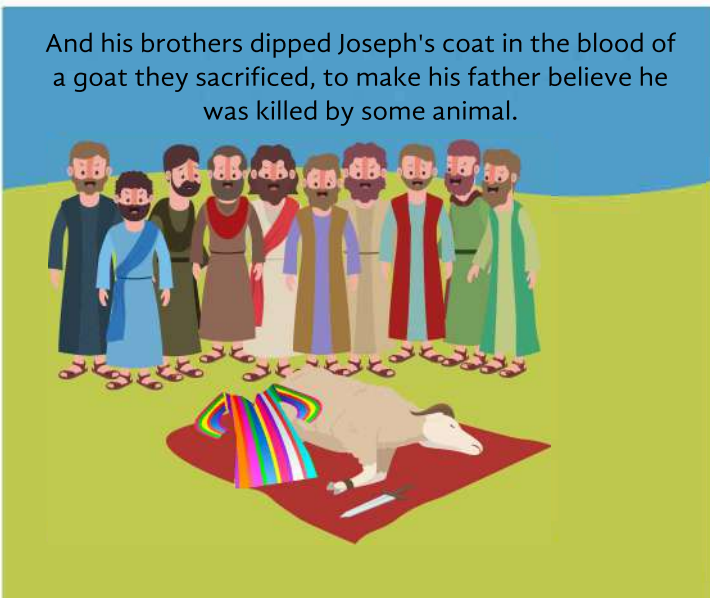
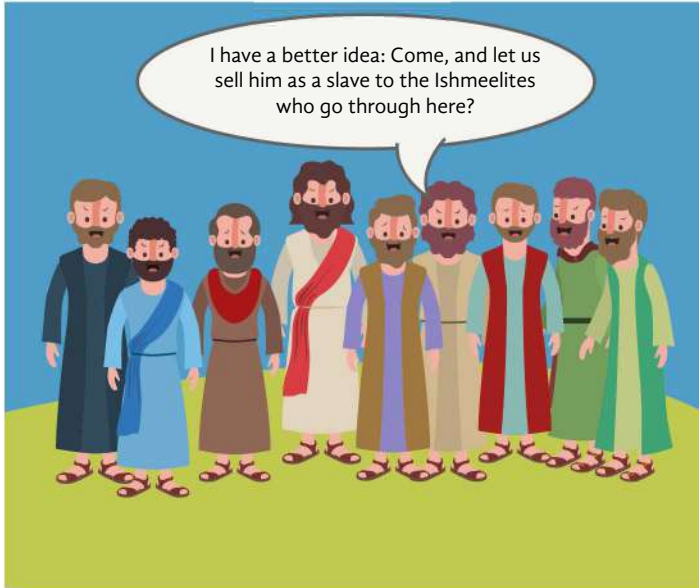

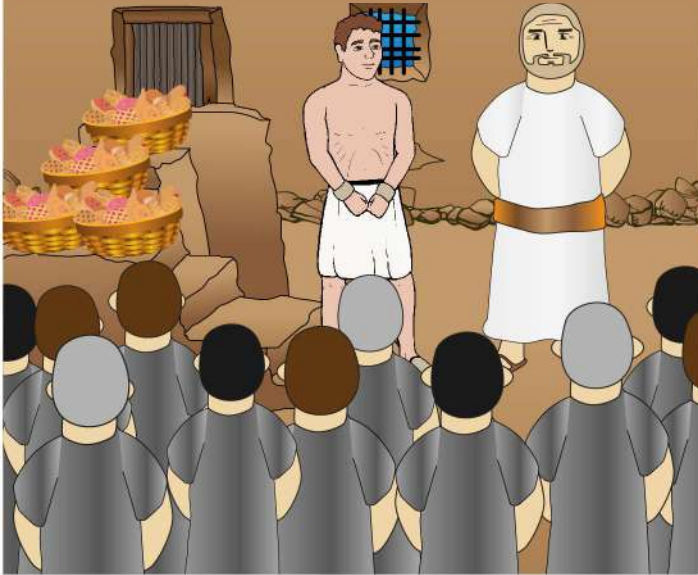
Brothers, what are you doing? Do not cast me in the pit!

And Pharaoh's cup was in my hand: and I took the grapes, and pressed them into Pharaoh's cup, and I gave the cup into Pharaoh's hand."

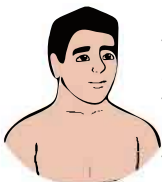


Genesis 40:12-14

7 good ears = 7 years of great plenty

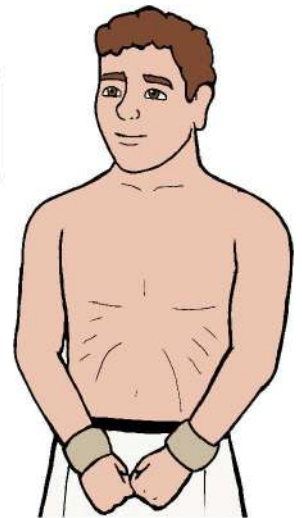
7 ill kine = 7 years of famine

Can we find such a one as this is, a man in whom the Spirit of God is?

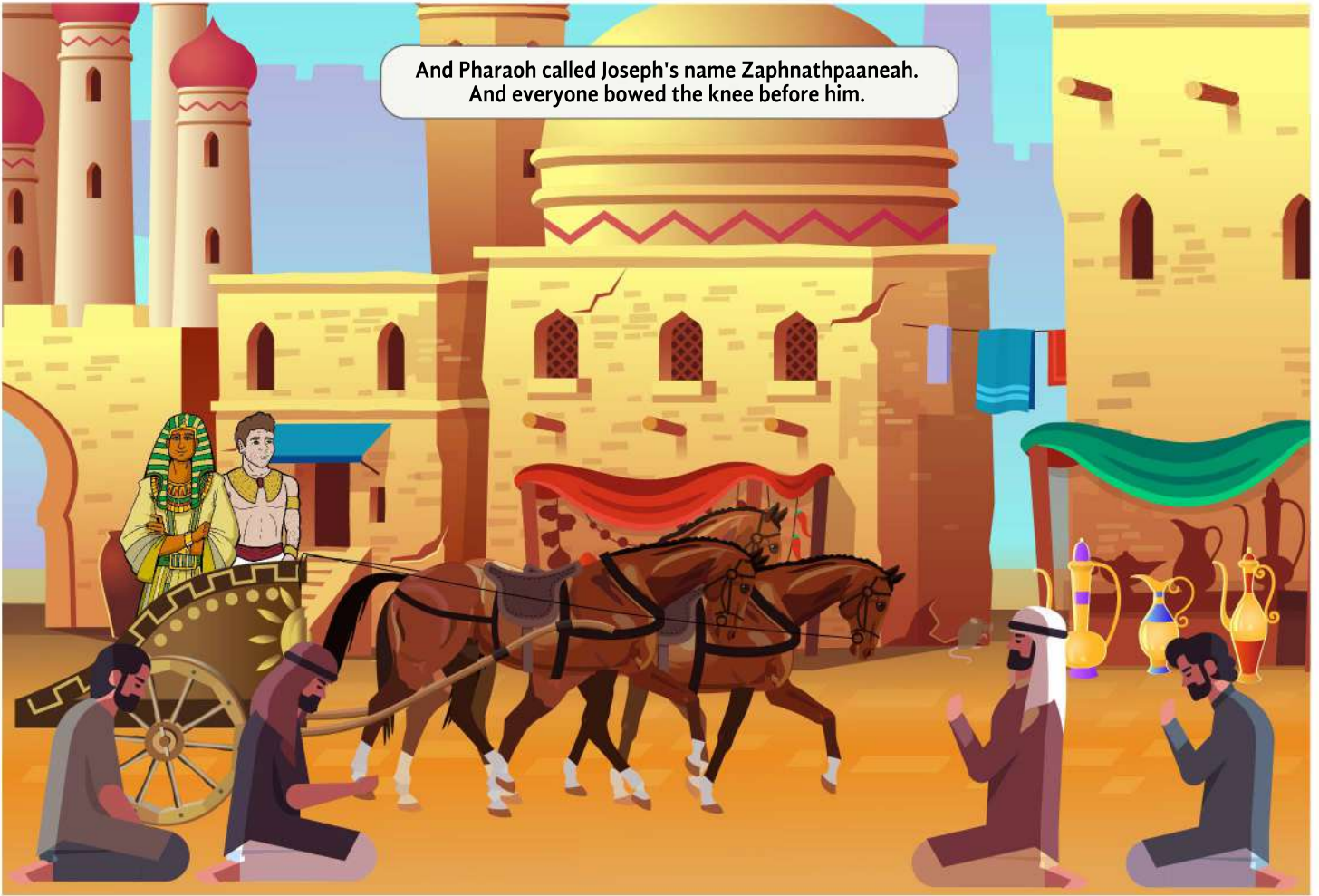


And Pharaoh set Joseph as administrator over all the land of Egypt.

And everyone bowed the knee before him.

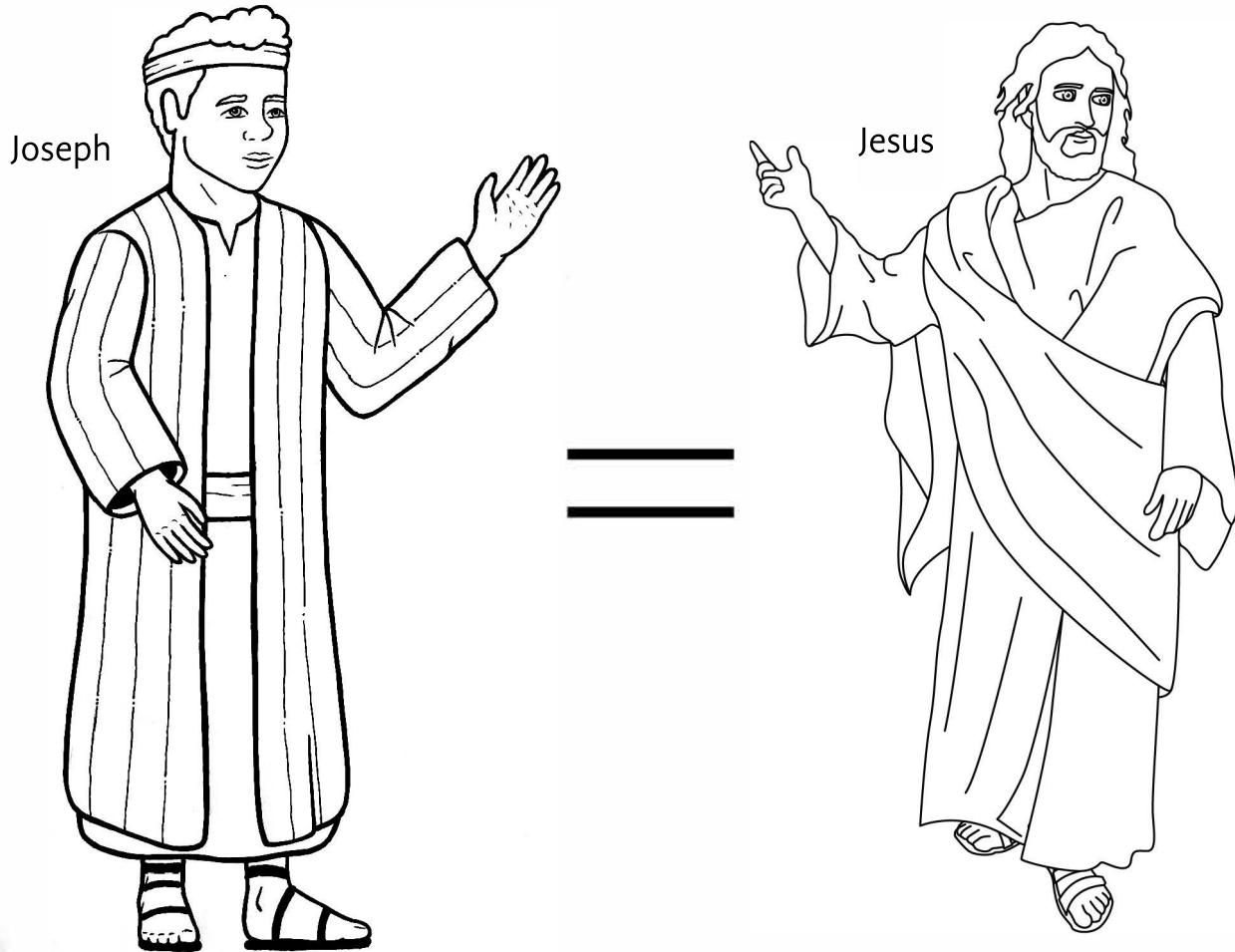


And he gave him as wife Asenath. And he had two sons: Manaseh and Ephraim.

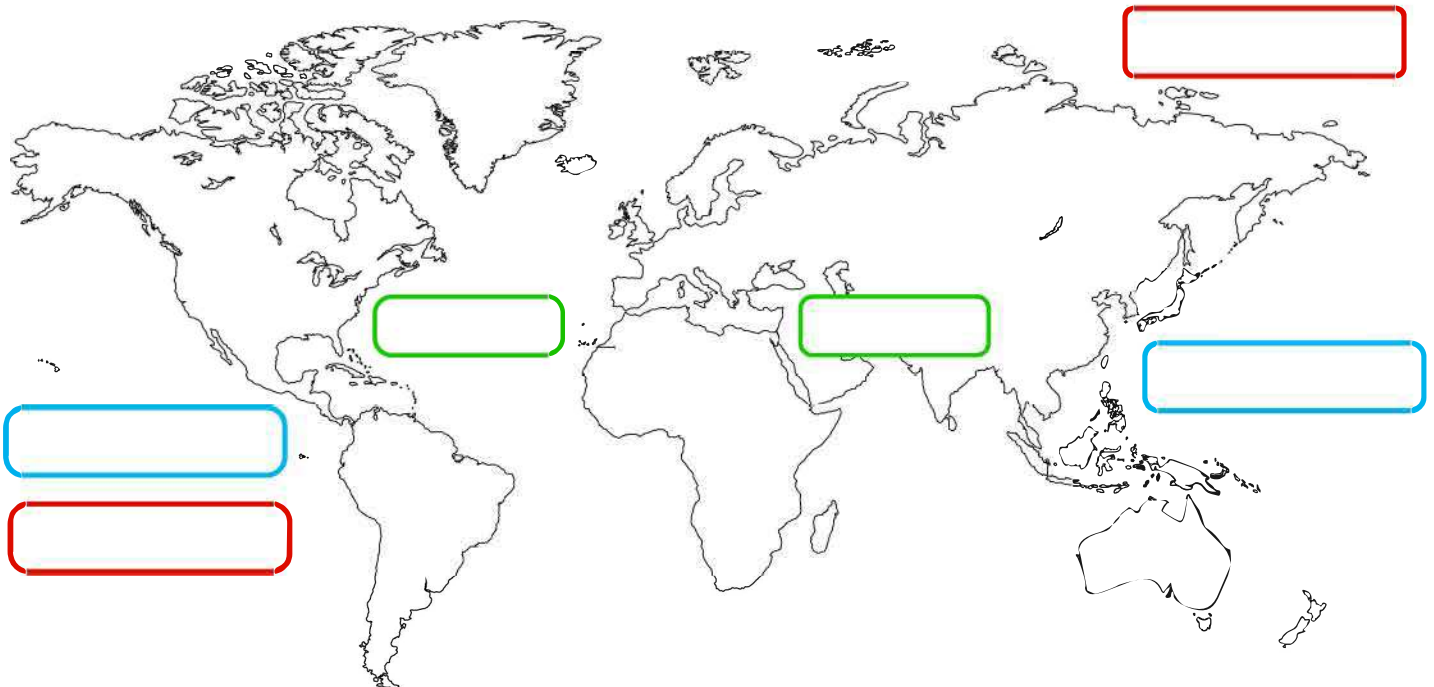

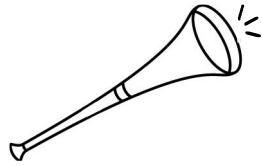
Jesus Christ will fulfill (like Joseph in Egypt) His 2nd Coming in the West among the Church of the Lord Jesus Christ under the New Covenant».

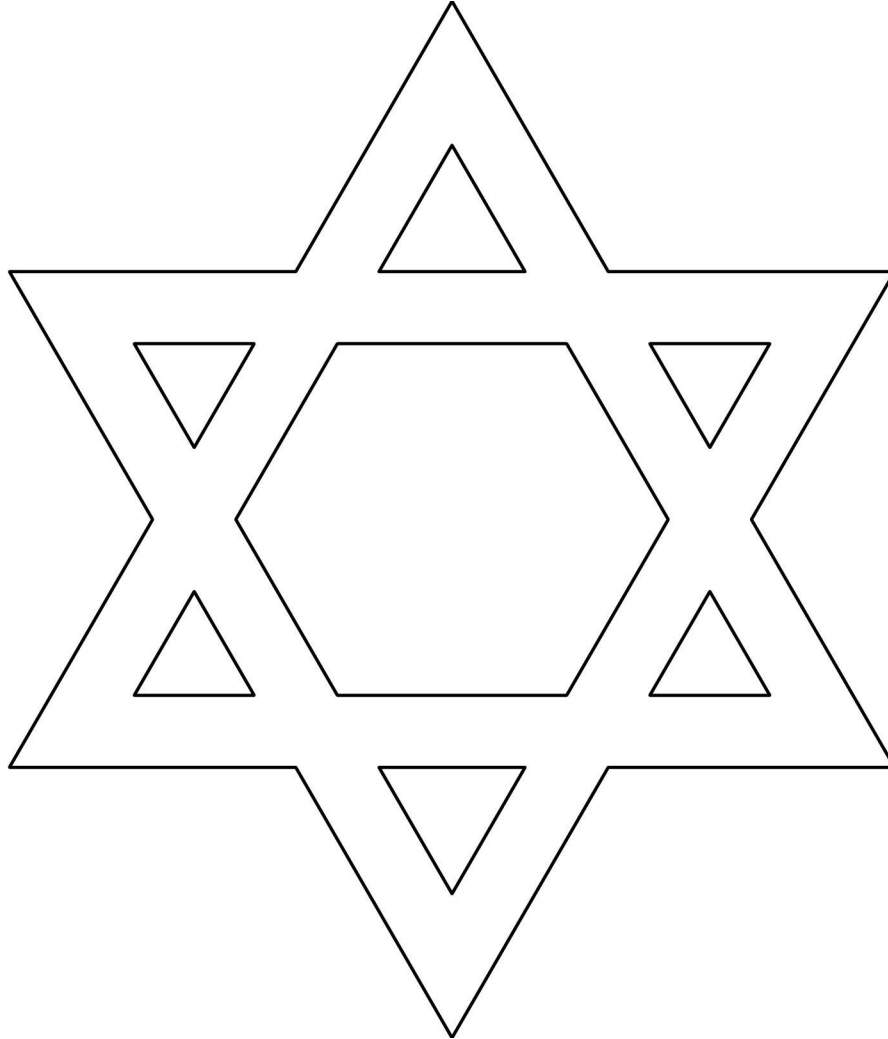

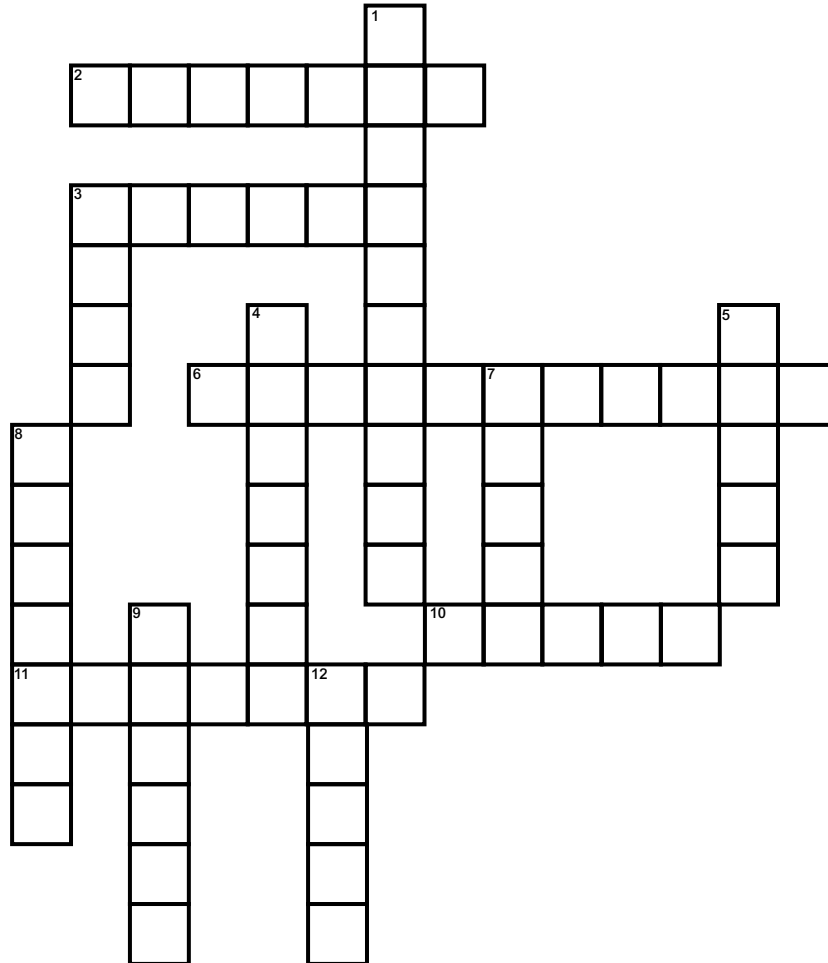
